COUNCIL CHAIRMAN 2013/2014

Councillor Gill Kendall has been elected to the position of Chairman of Newby and Scalby Parish Council.



Gill has lived in Newby Ward for 20 years and all her children have attended the local schools. She has been a Parish Councillor for three years and last year was Vice Chairman. Gill has a "can do" attitude and, as a busy mum and homemaker, she is also involved with many of the community groups and Church organisations in the area including Gallows Close Centre.

Gill is proud to have been chosen by her fellow councillors and hopes to justify their confidence in her and serve the parish and its parishioners well.

CHURCH BECK

Since 2010 Newby & Scalby Flood Working Group has been trying to get improvements to Church Beck. The group's chairman - Councillor Derek Bastiman - was pleased to learn recently that funding of £100,000 has been agreed by the Environment Agency in order to increase the width of the pipe which discharges Church Beck into the Sea Cut.

Negotiations with the Duchy of Lancaster regarding the re-alignment of the actual beck have proved pro-

tracted and frustrating. Derek appreciates the Duchy has come up with an alternative route for the re-alignment but admits to being bitterly disappointed that the Duchy is now seeking compensation.

Following discussions with the Environment Agency, Cllr. Bastiman is pleased at way it has responded to his request to cut back vegetation on the Sea Cut in an attempt to try and alleviate any future possible flooding issues before the essential works to Church Beck can be carried out. In his capacity as County Councillor, Derek is able to confirm that North Yorkshire County Council has allocated sums of money for the reinforcement of certain carriage-way areas both in Carr Lane and on Hackness Road.
